## 4th Annual Gator Walk-A-Thon

Aue students, staff, and parents will participate in our 4th Annual Gator Walk-A-Thon on Thursday, April 14th. This will serve as our second PTA fundraiser for this school year. All funds raised will be placed in the PTA general fund and will be used to support school programs at Aue. Please take this opportunity to support our school by helping your children obtain pledges. Pledge Forms will be sent home in manila envelopes on Monday,

March 21st. Students will have two weeks to get pledges from family, friends, neighbors, etc. Students will walk for one hour in the Aue gym to earn money for our school. Envelopes with funds earned are due back on Monday, April 4th. Students collecting pledges of \$30 or more will receive a FREE t-shirt to wear on the day of the event. The top fifteen earners school-wide will get to ride in a limo! There will also be ten wildcard winners selected from a

drawing on the morning announcements. These students will get to ride in the limo, too! Parents are welcome to participate in the Walk-A-Thon. T-shirts in adult sizes will be available for a donation of \$30. Please see the master schedule for the actual times students will be walking. Thanks for supporting our Aue PTA. This Walk-A-Thon is in lieu of catalog fundraising so we hope to have lots of participation from our Aue Gators.

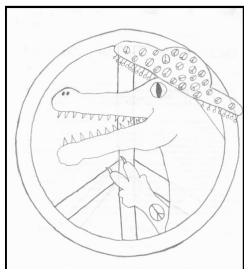

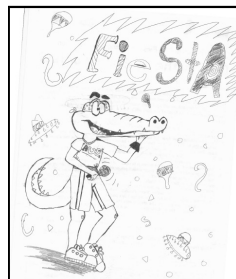

### Walk-A-Thon T-Shirt Contest A Huge Success

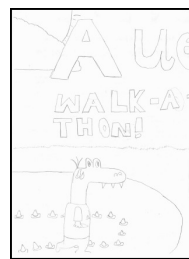

## Student Prizes & Awards for the Gator Walk-A-Thon

The Aue PTA is excited to announce the 4th Annual Walk-A-Thon list of incentives and awards. Students will take pledges prior to the event and then will walk for one hour on the day of the Walk-A-Thon. All proceeds benefit our school. The students earning money will be eligible for the following incentives and awards. Trophies and/or medals will be awarded during morning announcements at school on Thursday, April 14th. Limo rides will take place in early May.

### 2011 Incentives for Walk-A-Thon

**Tier 1:** Students earning a minimum of **\$5** will win a **GATOR NECKLACE** to wear to the Fiesta Fandango!

**Tier 2:** Students earning a minimum of **\$10** will win **6 CONFETTI EGGS** to crack on their friends at Fiesta Fandango, plus the gator necklace!

## 2nd Grade Shoebox Float Parade

All second grade students will be participating in a Shoebox Float parade again this year as part of their "San Antonio River City" social studies curriculum. All second graders will make their own float for the parade. Students should decorate a shoebox, at home, in any way they wish that is appropriate for school and Fiesta. They should **attach something to the float so that they can pull it along in the parade.** No decorated skateboards, remote control cars, or Barbie cars are allowed, just a decorated shoe box. The parade will start at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 14th. The parade route will begin in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade hallway and will wind around the halls ending at the cafeteria.
